Discipline at Club

Club Expenses

Each club night during handbook time, leaders listen to clubbers recite their verses and other handbook work. In order to pass a section, the entire section must be said in one sitting, with no more than two helps. When the entrance test is completed, you will be awarded an official membership and are eligible to purchase a uniform and handbook.
